



## Keevil Cof E Aided Primary School Homework Information

### Key Stage 1

Reading	There is no reading homework although there is an expectation that the child will read with an adult daily
Spelling	Y1 will be given sets of 'Tricky Words' to learn to spell and read. This is practiced at home and when the child is ready they will be assessed at school. Y2 have a weekly spelling test using a spelling pattern from letters and sounds
Other Homework	Year 2 will begin to practice their 2, 5, and 10 times tables

### Lower Key Stage 2

Reading	Children are responsible for changing their own reading books from the class book corner, they can do this any day. Guided Reading Homework is given following the class Guided Reading Rota. Activities will involve reading and/or writing about the text being shared.
Spelling	Weekly spelling test on a Friday. Children receive their new list of words to learn each Friday.
Times Tables	Children will complete a Times Table Challenge each Friday, and will then be given new tables to learn and practice for the following week.
Other Homework	This is handed out on a Wednesday to be returned the following Monday. Activities are usually maths or punctuation and grammar, but may involve other tasks such as research. Each term there is a Home-School Project during which time no other homework will be set.

### Upper Key Stage 2

Reading	Children are responsible for changing their own reading books from the class book corner, they can do this any day. Guided Reading Homework is given following the class Guided Reading Rota. Activities will involve reading and/or writing about the text being shared.
Spelling	Weekly spelling test on a Friday. Children receive their new list of words to learn each Friday.
Times Tables	Children will complete a Times Table Challenge each Tuesday, and will then be given new tables to learn and practice for the following week.
Other Homework	This is handed out on a Wednesday to be returned the following Monday. Activities are usually maths or punctuation and grammar, but may involve other tasks such as research. Each term there is a Home-School
