Coming into School

A normal day in Squirrel class

At the start of every morning the children complete morning work activities. This helps our brains wake up and become ready for a day of fun and exciting learning. We then start our phonics learning; phonics is taught though a variety of games, activities and writing tasks. We then move onto our literacy lesson where we complete some writing and reading activities. Playtime is next. Children will be able to enjoy some yummy, healthy snacks. After playtime we will start our maths lesson and enjoy using the maths resources to learn. After lunch, we take part in some different learning and activities including topic, science and art – plus much more. Twice a week we have a PE coach who comes into school and in the summer we go swimming! In Squirrel class we like to have fun, we sing, dance and even put on performances for the rest of the class. As the teacher, I will get to know the children in my class, their likes, dislike and plan around these so the children can learn through their interests.





Houses

We have three house teams in New Close – Longleat, Stourhead and Wilton. When you join us you will be placed into one of these houses. House points are awarded to children for hard work and good behaviour. Each week the house points are counted and shared in assembly and at the end of each term the house with the most house points is awarded a trophy. The children in the winning house are also rewarded with a special treat.







Lunch times

The children in Squirrel class can enjoy a healthy fruit/vegetable snack (provided by school or brought from home depending on preference). Lunch is served in our large hall and is free to children in Reception, Years 1 & 2. If you would like a school lunch, this will need to be pre-ordered weekly in advance. We can provide a hot meal or a packed lunch. Alternatively you can provide your own packed lunch. At meal times we try and encourage the children to be as independent as possible, but support them wherever they need it. We try to make lunch and snack time a sociable time where children are given time to chat and also to eat without rush.

Outdoor Area

As well as our large school playground we are also really lucky to have an extensive playing field including a woodland area.
