Our school times are:



A normal day in Fox Class

Throughout the week in Fox Class, the children will experience a broad and balanced curriculum. Mornings mostly start with Maths and Literacy then afternoons give the opportunity for interesting topic work and creative art projects. The children will also enjoy 2 PE sessions a week, including swimming for two terms.

As top of the school, the children in Fox Class will also be given extra special responsibilities, such as being prefects and assembly helpers. We will need two sports ambassadors to represent the school at local and in-school competitions as well as house captains to lead each of our school houses.

Houses

We have three house teams in New Close – Longleat, Stourhead and Wilton. When you join us you will be placed into one of these houses. House points are awarded to children for hard work and good behaviour. Each week the house points are counted and shared in assembly and at the end of each term the house with the most house points is awarded a trophy. The children in the winning house are also rewarded with a special treat.







Lunch times

Lunch is served in our large hall. Fresh, healthy meals are cooked on site by our catering team. If you would like a school lunch, this will need to be pre-ordered weekly in advance. We can provide a hot meal or a packed lunch. Alternatively you can provide your own packed lunch. We try to make lunch and snack time a sociable time where children are given time to chat and also to eat without rush.

As well as our large school playground we are also really lucky to have an extensive playing field including a woodland area.
