**THE COUNTY OF WILTSHIRE (WARMINSTER) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING, PROHIBITION OF STOPPING, TAXI RANK CLEARWAYS AND ON STREET PARKING) CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2019**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT Wiltshire Council proposes to make the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Traffic Management Act 2004, the effect of which will be to revoke The County of Wiltshire (Warminster) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Taxi Rank Clearways and On Street Parking) Consolidation Order 2017 (with Amendment Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4) and to re-enact it in the above Order the effect of which will be as follows:

- a) To introduce **No Waiting at any time** on the following length of road:  
**Woodcock Lane** – north side – from its junction with Imber Road for a distance of 82 metres in an easterly direction
- b) To introduce School keep clear entrance markings with the restriction **No Stopping Monday to Friday 8am - 6pm on entrance markings** on the following length of road:  
**Woodcock Lane** – south side – from a point 82 metres east of its junction with Imber Road for a distance of 43 metres in a westerly direction
- c) To introduce **No Waiting Monday to Friday 8am – 6pm** on the following length of road:  
**Woodcock Lane** – south side – from its junction with Imber Road for a distance of 44 metres in an easterly direction
