



English Curriculum Coverage and Progression 2019

At St Michael's we follow the National Curriculum.

Progression in **writing** is set out ([see appendix 1](#)) and delivered through Talk for Writing texts ([appendix 2](#)). There are 2 cycles to ensure no repetition for mixed age classes

Progression in **reading** is set out ([see appendix 3](#)) and delivered through whole class reading called Resilient Reader or RR. There is a balance of [domains](#) but a focus according to the most recent data analysis. For example, in Autumn term 2 this is on factual recall as result of the QLA from end of KS2 SATs 2019.

Progression in **spelling** is mapped and delivered through the No Nonsense spelling scheme (appendix [4](#), [5](#), [6](#), [7](#)) alongside the grammar progression (appendix [8](#) and [9](#)).

Progression in handwriting is delivered through [ISHA](#) framework.
