



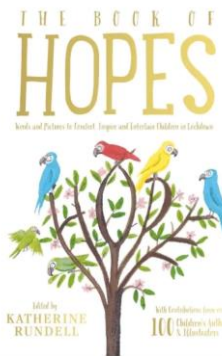
St Michael's Junior Church School Reading Portal

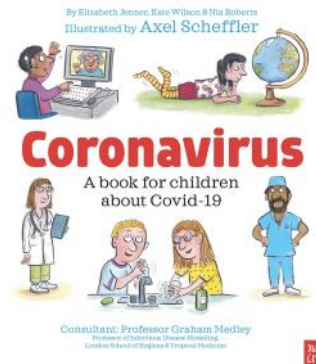

[Borrow Box](#) – Bath and North East Somerset library members can checkout up to 5 audiobooks at a time.



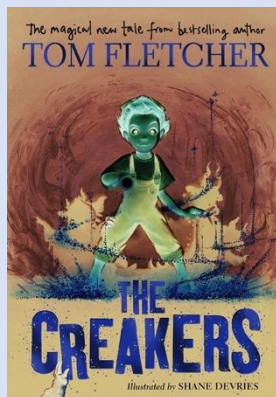
