### Message from Mrs Giblett

#### Science & Arts Week

In their EoY survey completed last July, the children told us that the thing they most enjoyed about school last year was the great range of class topics. Staff were delighted with this feedback and this year we are focusing on enhancing our curriculum provision even more.

We had lovely, positive feedback from children and parents about our Wow Maths enrichment day back in January where children immersed themselves in practical shape activities. Some great work was produced including origami pictures and collage symmetry kites, all of which can be seen displayed in the Y2/3/4 corridor.

This half-term, we have gone one better with a week of enrichment to coincide National Science and Arts Week. I am sure that your child will have shared their curricular experiences with you but could we encourage you to go to our Twitter feed to get a flavour of the fun and excitement that we have enjoyed in school this week.

A huge thank you to all the staff for being so enthusiastic in planning & delivering this special week, especially at the end of a busy term when we can all be feeling a little tired.

#### School Clubs

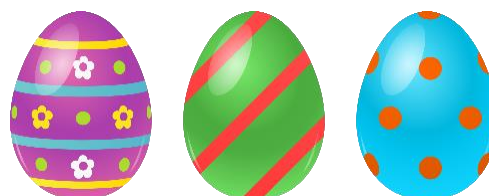
### Bosvigo Holiday Club



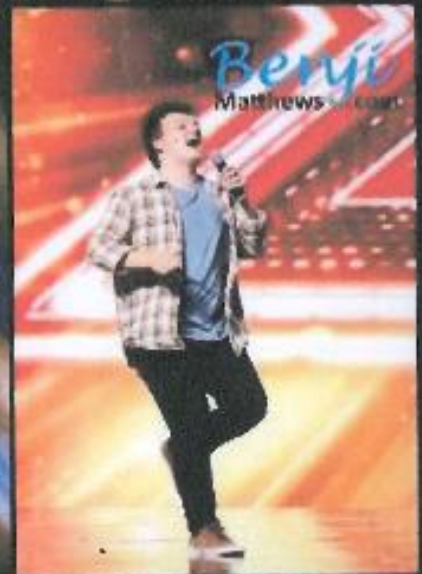
