

Residential Trip to Isle of Wight 2022

We are very pleased to announce that we are able to offer 40 places on our residential trip to Little Canada in Wootton Creek, Ryde, in the Isle of Wight. We shall be leaving school on **Monday 13th June 2022** and returning **Friday 17th June 2022**, travelling by coach and ferry.

Little Canada is owned and run by PGL who run a number of centres in the UK and Europe. Some activities will be hosted each day and evening at the centre, but we have also booked to visit some places outside the centre. We are planning to visit Osborne House, which was once home to Queen Victoria and Prince Albert. We will also visit, The Needles and Alum bay Glassmakers and Amazon World, which is home to some of the world's most unusual, beautiful and endangered creatures.

The trip is going to cost approximately **£450** per child and this includes accommodation, food, all travel costs, the glass workshop and entrance to Amazon World. However, a final figure will be given once numbers and excursions are confirmed.

We would ask that you book a place by completing the reply slip, together with an initial deposit of **£50.00** by **no later than Friday 24th September 2021**. **Please note the £50.00 deposit cannot be made online.**

Please note, once the deposit has been passed onto PGL it is non-refundable. Booking, as in previous years, will be on a first come, first served basis, however, preference will be given to children in Year 6 in the first instance.
