Lunchtime will be slightly later at 12:15 but you'll be so busy having fun that you won't even have time to notice.

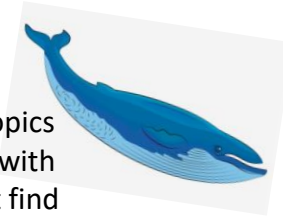


## What will you learn?
