Headteacher's Comments

Thank you so much for your support this half term. We are so proud of what our children are achieving despite the many challenges we have all faced this year. Your contribution to this cannot be underestimated, we appreciate all you have done. Now that COVID restrictions are easing, Mrs Jayne Banner and I have been able to do observations throughout school. We are so impressed with what we have seen: super teaching, hardworking children and fantastic behaviour. We are so proud of our school and our partnership with the community. We are looking forward to welcoming another 60 children in September but, although there are currently waiting lists for many year groups, we have no plans to further expand, but want to continue to build on what we have right now and enable our children to flourish within this lovely supportive environment.

The children will be able to enjoy a longer Spring Bank Holiday this time which they fully deserve, due to the extra two INSET Days. There are some major changes to our curriculum which will make teaching and learning even more exciting with subject development and the new Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum high on the agenda. You may have heard that we have also been granted a large amount of money for what is being termed as the Recovery Curriculum. This is fantastic news, but we do need to plan carefully. I appreciate that two INSET Days can be inconvenient, but I must stress that every school has 5 INSET Days per year and these are two of them. We do try to build our INSET Days onto normal holidays so that they are more manageable for parents and there are fewer breaks.
