## Public Health England COVID symptom advice

We would like to reiterate the PHE advice on COVID symptoms and when a PCR test is required. The core symptoms are as they have always been, despite media coverage of possible new ones, so we only act on these:

- *Change to taste/smell*
- *high temperature*
- *new, persistent cough.*
