This year's football team (Parc Eglos Reds) have reached the final of the Diamond Shield. The semi-final was played at Helston AFC's ground on Friday 14th May. Our opponents were Archbishop Benson, against whom we always have very competitive games. The first five minutes of the match were tight. Their defenders didn't give Rio many opportunities to get into space and Austin's attempts to dribble his way towards goal were thwarted. Then, as half time neared, Austin charged down the right wing, cut inside and hit a great strike past the stranded goalkeeper. Within moments of the second half starting, Olly could have had two goals - he came incredibly close and was unlucky not to score. Both of these chances gave the team a lot of confidence and suddenly it looked like Parc Eglos were in control of the game.
