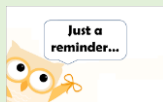
Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> December- LAST DAY OF TERM

This week the school were visited by Olympic Bronze medallist- Melissa Reid. She won Bronze in Rio 2016 as a Triathlete. She shared her modified swim goggles around to the children, so they could see what it is like being visually impaired. She shared, how she overcame obstacles along the way, including a dislike of swimming in the beginning.

The rain has returned but that hasn't stopped our new Reception children venturing up to the woods with some hot chocolate. Class 1 have been making gloop as part of their science experiment. They have been learning about the country code, ready for their camp next week, along with doing a display. Year 2 have continued their lessons with Mrs Harvey in their own classroom.

Class 2 have completed their Myth of Sisyphus comic strips, and started planning an alternative ending for the legend of Jan Tregeagle. In Maths, they have been solving addition and subtraction calculations using the mental method. They enjoyed playing games to learn about Anglo Saxon crime, and punishment.

In class 3, Year 6 pupils have been doing practice SATS papers with Mr Turnham this week. They have been looking at Health and nutrition and learning about the impact this has on their bodies.

### Year 1

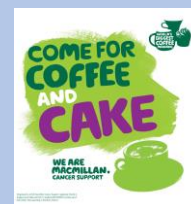
If your child is in **Class 2** please ensure you send them in with their kit next week.

Another uniform order will be going in shortly. If you would like a school coat for your child, please arrange payment of £19.99 via ParentPay or pay in the office.

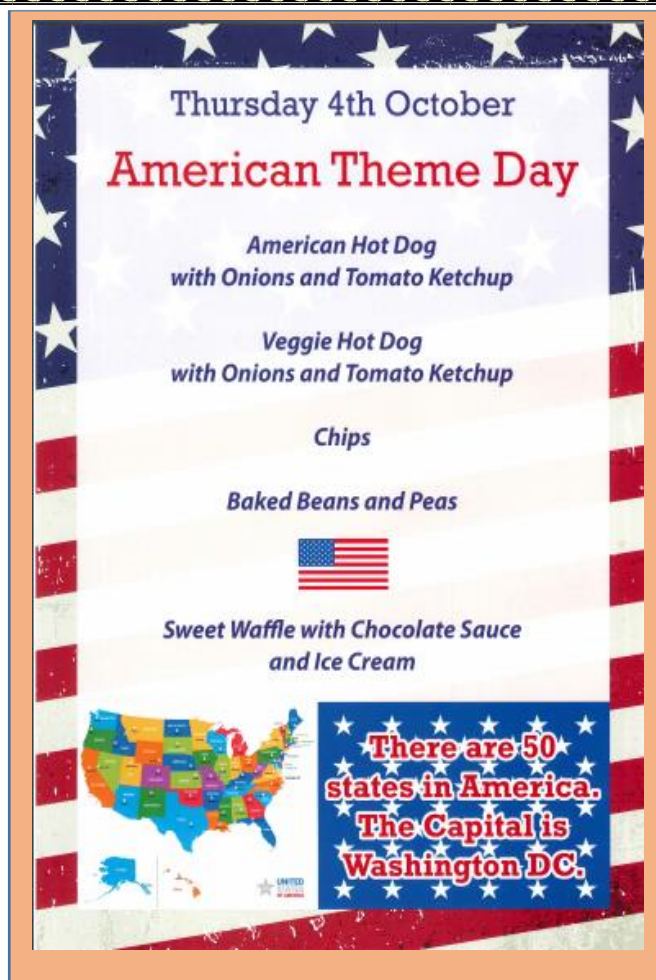
Please advise Miss Hicks of the size you require. Miss Hicks does have one available in her office to purchase at present. (age 9/10)
