Can I take this opportunity to thank all of you for your enthusiasm and support in helping us build Warbstow into the wonderful school that it is.

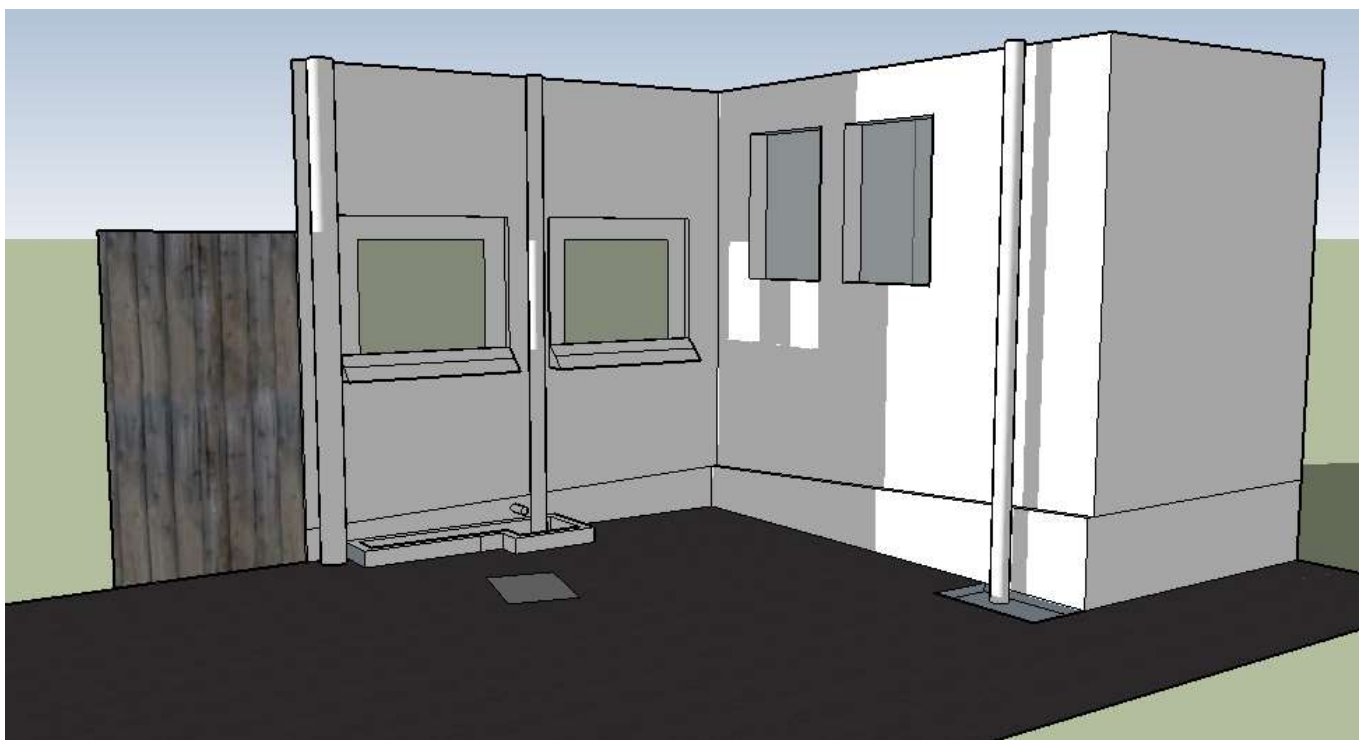
I know that you will give Mr Ellis all the support that you have given me and I have every confidence that the school will continue to thrive under his leadership.
