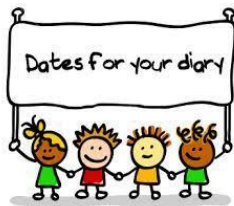

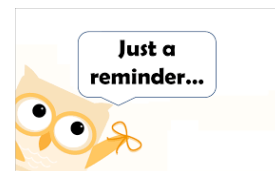
This week Class 2 have written a recount of their "snow day" and continued researching clouds to write a non-chronological report. In Maths we have been practising times tables and divide.

Ready for handover during the Easter Holidays as promised.

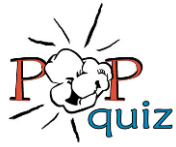


Camp Kernow meeting on Tuesday at 3.20 in Class 3 for all parents of Year5/6.
