A Message from Our Head of School

A fantastic start to the term, well done everyone. Happy smiley faces on children and parents in the mornings. We now have a boat in pre-school with pirate sail, a fully operational car park and full attendance apart from a few sniffles from children.

School lunches are up to their normal high standard, this week Sam and Jo cooked butternut squash from our own school garden, delicious! Front and back playgrounds are in full use on a rotation with bubble 1 and 2 (weekly), and this is working very well. Handwashing, one-way systems and routines are becoming well embedded and part of our school culture. New fences at the front of school and a gate at the top of our field have been installed. We await matching gates at the front!

Drop off Pick up up-date.

Thank you for your support with the arrangements so far. Social distancing has improved outside the school gates and it seems an altogether calmer and safer procedure.

As I mentioned at the start of the term some minor adjustments may need to be made.

These are because class 1 and 2 drop off outside the new classrooms are becoming congested when parents (understandably) attempting to drop off children for both classes at the same time.

The most simple and manageable solution will be to drop off your child during your allocated time slot (class 1), then loop around again when class 2 opens. Please ensure you drop your child off in the correct timeslot as we are seeing an increased amount in late arrivals.

I will take charge of your class 2 children and class 3 children in the front playground as needed. This will ease the congestion and stop the waiting in the back playground.

Also, please be aware that the carpark is now available for you to use. If there is a space in it, please use it and reduce the impact on residents' verges and pavements.
