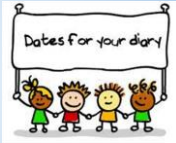

## A true Warbstow Warrior

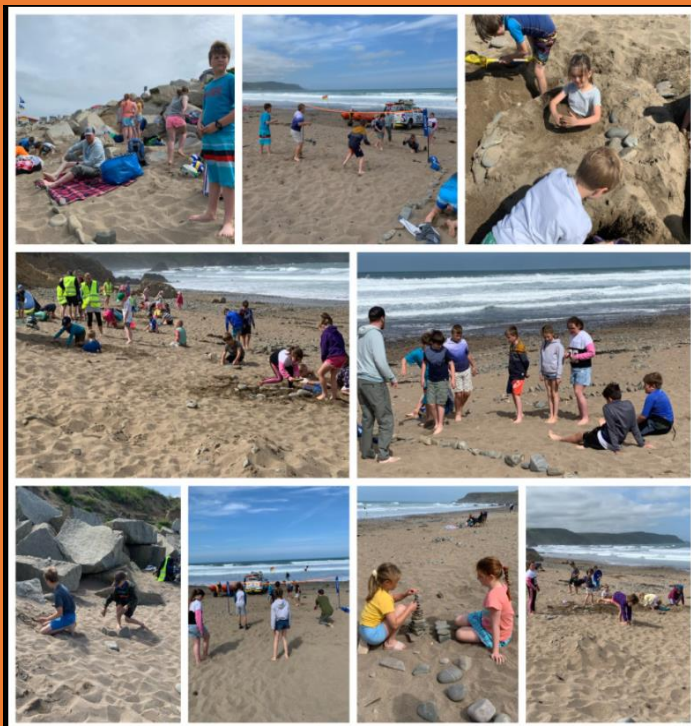
