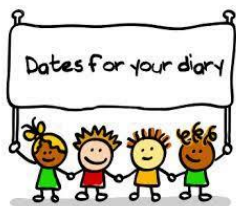

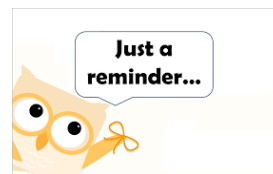
In class 2 they have been tackling fractions this week and continuing their non-chronological reports about clouds. They have also explored climate around the world and learnt about why some countries are hotter than others.

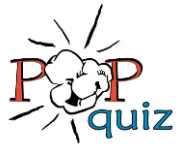
Classroom build update

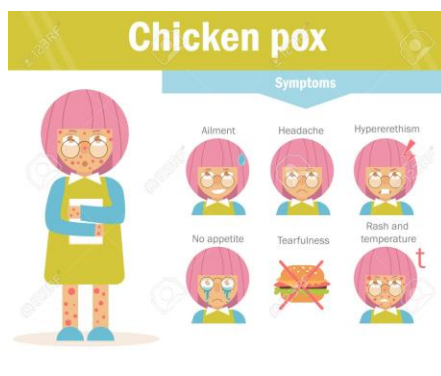

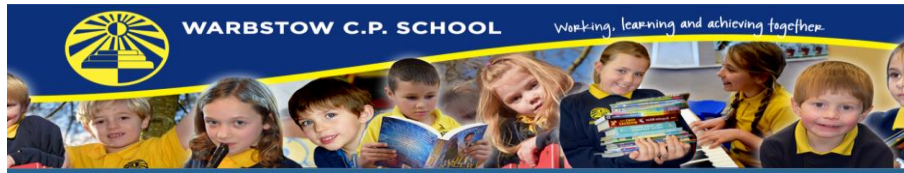
Chickenpox
