

A big well done to our KS1 football team who this week travelled to Tregadillett school for a tournament only to find out that it had been cancelled! Tregadillett pulled together an afternoon of football nonetheless and they won every game they played. Well done 😊

This week class 1 have been writing poems about blue. They have been counting groups in 2,5 and 10s. In Science, the children learnt how many hours of sunshine there are in different seasons.

This week in class two, we have been learning how to write poems, and act them out using actions. We have also been learning about the history of flight, and about early inventors. The children have designed and built their own toy planes, which they will test in flight next week. In science they are looking at the weather and the seasons. In Maths the children have been learning how to make and write fractions of shapes and numbers.

This week class 3 have listened to some poems before writing their own, depicting one stage of the digestive system. Some have already shared theirs with the class. In Maths, Year 3 have been identifying right angles in 2D shapes, and Year 4 have been calculating mass using decimals. For DT we designed our own ideal meal before a healthy meal after learning about the food groups, and how we need all of them in proportion to have a healthy diet.

Class 4 have been writing a recount of the "Great Fire of London". In Maths, their focus has been fractions, simplifying and ordering. In Science, they have been observing the effects of different solutions on eggs, used to represent the teeth.



This week we have been hit with a nasty sickness bug. Please can we remind all parents that your child must be off school until they are 48 hours clear of any sickness and/or diarrhoea. Many thanks


