This week the whole school had a fantastic workshop from the charity 'Soundwaves', and a fantastic performance from the quartet "Graffiti Classics"

Class 1 have produced some fantastic independent writing about the "Three Little Pigs". In Maths, they have been finding the 'difference'. We are very proud of all the children at swimming, they have gained confidence, stamina, and technique.

Year 2 have been using verbs, adjectives, nouns, and time connectives to write instructions on how to catch a wolf. In Maths, they have been learning how related maths facts can help them solve maths problems. They are all working hard on learning the times tables. They have their Sumsdogs passwords in their bookbags, and need to explore this website over half term.

Class 2 this week have continued with their focus on influential people. They have been looking at their research notes made from their homework, and shared their findings with each other.

In Maths, Class 3 have been investigating 3-D shapes, and their properties. In English, they are developing a comic strip focussed on health and well-being. In French, they have been learning about the body, and how to name external features.
