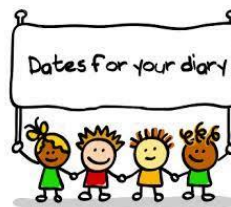

FunFit has started again, please remember your child may have a free first taster session. Sessions run on a Tuesday and Thursday morning in the community hall from 8-8.45. All children age 3+ are welcome. FunFit is an exciting programme that develops co-ordination, balance and fitness and helps develop important motor skills which help with handwriting, concentration and builds confidence and self-esteem. A half term pass this half term is £10 for 1 day, £20 for 2 days or £3 per session. For larger families if you buy 2 passes the third one is free.

**Attendance**

**School year to date: 94.99%**

As you can see our whole school attendance is below 95%, our target is to achieve at least in line with the National Average of 96%. Disappointingly we have not achieved this since 2014. In the past this has been partly due to a small number of pupils with long term sickness. However, there are an increasing number of families taking term time holidays which is unacceptable. If your child's attendance is below 95% you will today receive their attendance report unless your child is age 4 and under. We will be monitoring your child's attendance over the next few weeks to see if there is an improvement.

In school, to encourage the children's attendance, we have re-introduced our weekly class attendance competition with the winning class looking after Ricky our school mascot for the week.
