Art

During this unit pupils will:

Knowledge

Celtic art linked to the Anglo Saxon topic in History

Study the Art work of Andy Goldsworthy and use natural local resources to create sculptures outdoors.

Skills

Create and use patterns and shapes in nature, the environment and different cultures and times.

Create complex surface textures by mixing and combining techniques.

During this unit pupils will:

Knowledge

During this unit pupils will:

History

During this unit pupils will:

Knowledge

The children will be able to say who the Anglo Saxons were and when and why they invaded Britain.

Skills

Compare and contrast events from different historical periods (Vikings, Ancient Greece)

Explain how life has changed.

Analyse historical evidence and artefacts to make claims about Anglo Saxon life and culture.
