

Where will I find work for my child?

You will need to visit our school website at www.andoversford.eschools.co.uk

You will not need to login, but will just need to select 'Pupil Pages' and your child's class.



Teachers will upload work for your children every Monday and Wednesday. Please support your children in accessing the activities, and in completing them.



The Virtual Learning Environment


We will also be using the Virtual Learning Environment (VLE) to allow pupils to submit work to us when requested, or to allow teachers to give feedback. You can login using the login button at the top right hand corner of the website:



To login, children will need to use their picture password, which has been sent home.



Press 'Picture Login' and use the password (made up of four icons). This will enable your child to log in.



Sending work to your child's class teacher


There may be times where your child is asked to share their work with their teacher if possible- this will be indicated within the main work set on the webpage. This will also allow teachers to give feedback where appropriate.

Sign in to the child's account, as above.

On the dashboard, click on the 'My Class' button.

Then look for the 'Homework' tab at the side of the page.

The homework task will then be displayed. Click on this task.
