**6P with 97.1%**

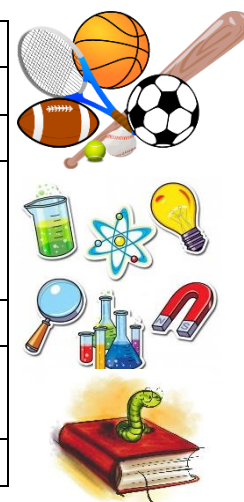
65 children achieved **100% attendance** for the term.
