Reading is always important for you to do and it is essential for you to read on a daily basis while you are at home. To challenge yourself further you could also answer some AIR reading questions in your home school diary for example-

- How do you think your main character has changed throughout the text?
- Which other texts do you know that have a similar setting to the book you are reading?
- Which theme from our books for life is your text most linked to? (Overcoming the monster, rags to riches, the quest, voyage and return, comedy, tragedy or rebirth)

Another way to further your reading is to write a review of your book. You could create your own template for this however there are many other examples online.
