Home learning- A guide for parents of pupils in Year 1 and Year 3.

From Monday 4th January we will be uploading resources to your child's google classroom. As soon as arrangements change we will let you know immediately.

To be able to access their home learning, each child will need to follow a straightforward and now familiar process that requires access to the internet on either a **laptop**, a **chrome book**, a **tablet** or a **smartphone** for a period of time each day.

All pupils have their own login for this classroom and they have all been shown how to use it regularly by their teachers. The work can only be accessed through your **child's google account/login**. Please find also attached to this email a google classroom guide.

We will also send access instructions to you individually if you realise that your child is unsure of these. If any child does not have/has forgotten their login please contact Mrs Ratcliffe on the following email: p.ratcliffe@huntingtonprimaryacademy.co.uk

Our aim is that by 9.00am on each day of bubble closure that the children in the class will have a series of activities to complete during that day. These then need to be 'turned in' on the classroom or 'shared with the teacher' who will respond and reply to the work completed.

We hope that staff will be able to respond to any queries or to look at your child's work as appropriate between the hours of 9.00am - 12.00pm and 1.00pm - 3.00pm from Monday to Friday.

Please also find below some suggestions for activities that children could complete alongside the activities provided by their teachers.

- Your child can read their reading books/any other book that they can read independently with fluency and understanding.

- Your child could practise their phonics/sounds as suggested by their teachers.
- Times tables are so important for the basis of understanding in maths so your child could spend time learning these.
- Those children who join the Lexia and IDL sessions could use their logins that are in their diaries.
