



PROPOSED SPEND FOR PE AND SPORTS GRANT 2019 - 2020

During this period, we anticipate that Huntington Primary Academy will receive £20,200 to promote and sustain the wide range of high quality sports provision and activities already in place for our pupils plus £3,213 carry over from 2018-2019 funding. Estimated total is £23,413

We will continue to abide by the following six general principles for the use of this grant:

- To increase engagement in sport from an early age, that is for our youngest pupils
- To identify and offer additional provision outside normal school hours for target groups of pupils, that is those pupils who have not previously attended out of school sports provision
- To provide a wider range of sporting experiences for those pupils who have already shown that they are skilled and talented in sport
- To provide additional out of school sports activities across the school (including Y5 and Y6 Residential Visits)
- To promote and provide our pupils with access to competitive sports tournaments in a range of sports
- To access training for our staff which is focused on providing high quality PE and sports provision across the school

The following list shows how Huntington Primary Academy plan to spend the 2019/2020 PE and Sports Grant

- Funding for all Y5 pupils to take part in a sports - based overnight activities and stay at Huntington Primary Academy and for a sports coach to attend (£350).
- Funding extra staffing and coaching to enable Y4 pupils to learn to swim in smaller groups (£900).
- 'Top-up'/free swimming lessons, staffing and transport for Y6 pupils who are not meeting the end of KS2 requirements for swimming (£1000).
- Subsidising fees, staff costs for the longer sports- based residential visit for some Y6 pupils to attend (£1,400).
- Funding travel, supply costs and first aider to enable pupils and their families to attend regional or national sporting events in or out of school time with a sports coach (£4,500).
- Funding a 'Super Saturday Sports Club' for EYFS and KS1 pupils (£4,100).
- Funding time for administrative assistants to carry out admin tasks for tournaments etc. (£1,500).
- Funding for cover and training on the delivery of high quality PE/sports/games activities/active sessions for staff and PE subject leader (£ 2,250).
- Funding for sports coaches to promote sport and physical activity at lunch times (£3,000).
- Fund playground markings to improve quality of play at break and lunch times (£4,413).
