Dear Parents/Carers

City of York Council Pedestrian Training - Year 3

Your child's class will undertake a practical training course run by the City of York Council, to help them cross the road safely. To make the training effective it is important that you read this letter. The Council have funding this year so are able to provide Pedestrian Training free of charge to families.

Pedestrian Training is carried out during school hours on roads near the school. The course is comprised of two 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ hour sessions in which a simple plan for crossing roads will be taught. Children may also be shown how to use zebra, pelican, puffin and toucan crossings in addition to pedestrian facilities at traffic light controlled junctions and pedestrian islands, if any of these are close to the school.

During training your child will be supplied with a high visibility vest for their safety. **We would also request that you ensure they have warm and dry clothing. Training will only be cancelled if the trainers feel it is unsafe to undertake the training due to the weather conditions.**

Completion of the course will not mean that your child is capable of coping with the road environment on their own. This is only the beginning of a long learning process, which will continue into adult life. It is essential that you help your child to practise what they have learnt on their course.

If you are DBS cleared through the school and would like to volunteer as a helper on the sessions, please complete the relevant part of the permission slip. We will need at least 4 helpers on each session.
