ENGLISH

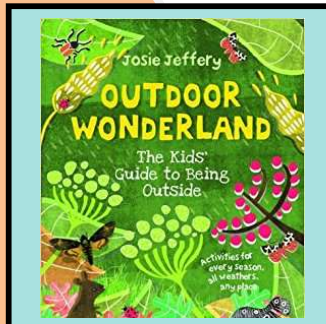
Our English work will include:

- Developing sentences: using different tenses, ad prefixes & suffixes, using a variety of punctuation



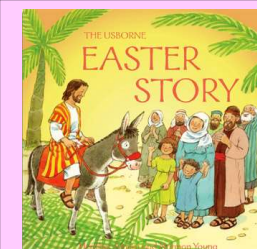
SCIENCE
