Children will be learning:

- listen to On The Way Home by Jill Murphy on YouTube
- to read and write captions and information about plants, trees and gardens.
- to create, describe and write about our own "Fantasy Story" characters.
- To read, retell, sequence, and describe the characters in other well-known author books.
- Non-fiction texts – Information texts – The past – trains, Victorians, Edwardians and George Stephenson.
- to name the simple parts of a sentence,
- to name, explain and use: full stops, capital letters, question and exclamation marks.
- to read and write common irregular words
- to sound out all letter sounds Set 1 to Set 3 Read Write Inc. Letter sounds



Parents & Children - Homework Activities

- **To make a picture – by drawing around and using all of our sterling coins. Use them as many times as you like to create an artistic picture of something to do with the past (Victorian/Edwardian).**
- **Make a clock or a watch at home. You only need card, pens and split pin.**

Science and Computing

Children will be learning:

- Wild Plants – naming plants in your environment.
- Common plants and weeds and the Summer Season – looking at seasonal changes.
- we will learn about what plants need to grow.
- to ask simple questions and recognise that they can be answered in different ways.
- to make observations, gather evidence and information to help answer questions.
- use The Orchard as a stimulus or trees in your local area - looking at different trees – how they grow and the parts of a tree.
- to look at other plants that give us food? Talk about the differences between fruit, vegetables, nuts and seeds. School 360 – research – search engines link with History and Geography.

Art and Design

Children will be making pictures, cards and other crafts around the theme of plants, flowers and the countryside. Creating images/sketches of people and places in Wylam, now & past.

Humanities

Geography – Looking at our local environment – the school, playing fields, village etc. Recapping map work from last term. History – Famous people – George Stephenson, Queen Victoria, Beamish, Life in the past.
