

Literacy

Our reading and writing focus will include: Information Texts ,Letter Writing, Diaries, Informal/Formal Invitations and Postcards.

When writing,the children will be working on organising paragraphs around a theme.

They will be encouraged to use:

- fronted adverbials in sentences, remembering to add the comma after the fronted adverbial
- prepositional phrases in writing
- the correct verb tenses in writing

Please continue at home with practising spelling and handwriting that is joined, legible and consistent in size.

Computing

Children will be learning how to make a short i-movie ! A very exciting project .

Mrs Newall will be checking who has access to the Apple i-movie app and building the project from there.

Science - Plants (cont'd)

To identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants – roots, stem, trunk, leaves, flowers

Explore the requirements of plants for life and growth – lights, air, nutrients.

Investigate the ways in which water is transported within plants

Explore the part that flowers play in the lifecycle of a plant, including pollination, seed formation and seed dispersal.

Mathematics

To continue to practise timestables and opposite division facts.

To recognise equivalent fractions

To compare and order unit fractions, and fractions with the same denominators

To add and subtract fractions with the same denominator within 1 whole

To tell the time from a digital and analogue clock, including using Roman numerals and 12 and 24 hour clocks

Record and compare time in terms of seconds, minutes, hours

To compare the duration of events.
