Dear Parent/Carer

We would like to share with you our Digital Strategy, as we move forward reflecting on current government guidance and the impact of Covid19. This will include our normal offer and the range of possible circumstances that may occur.

We are continuing to develop and share activities in all the classrooms to support and familiarize the children with how to use and access digital learning using the Seesaw platform. The children will now all have at least three Virtual School activities, connected to their learning in class that should be completed as part of their home learning.

Many of the outcomes will be able to be completed digitally. However, some Maths and Writing tasks may require paper to structure and complete their learning. To support this, we will be giving all the children a lined A5 book and squared A5 book. This will help us to maintain and reinforce expectations and standards that we teach in school. For Early Years there will be a lined book for writing & a book with blank pages for maths. These books are for your child to work from at home, photos can then be taken and uploaded to Tapestry/Seesaw.

Here is an outline of our offer and how we intend to adapt to each of the different circumstances.

This may include phone calls / video chats with child's 1:1 support. They will usually be expected to still complete the learning.</li> <li>• In line with Aspire policy there will not be streaming of live lessons.</li> </ul>
