As a school we have used the Inspire Curriculum to ensure that all primary subjects are covered in an exciting, stimulating and relevant way.

From the conception we were involved in helping the Inspire team to produce planning for mixed age classes.

We are always open to actively engaging in a process of review, adaptation and change with these resources. We take the best parts of the topic-based curriculum materials and injecting increased Challenge, Higher Expectations and develop a strategy to enhance Long Term Memory Fluency.

Making topics increasingly relevant to pupils experience and the changing landscape of their own knowledge and understanding is important to maintain engagement, motivation and success in teaching and learning through the curriculum on offer.

The Warbstow Inspire Curriculum is made up of 42 themed units, 6 for each year group. Each unit is taught over approximately 6 weeks and crosses subjects so that children can transfer their learning from one subject to another.

Curriculum Enrichment

We offer a range of after school clubs such as cricket, athletics, track, Eco, running, keep fit, cycling, Lego, choir and more. These alter each term so please look at our current list under Parents/Extra-curricular clubs.

On a Wednesday afternoon the Junior children are fortunate to be able to take part in some excellent music lessons. They are divided into 3 different groups and receive samba drumming, violin and cello, and singing tuition. Each term the children have the opportunity to perform the pieces they have learnt at our music assembly. In addition, our specialist teachers offer Guitar and Cello lessons at school as part of the Cornwall Music Service Trust to small groups/individuals.

The school also takes part in many of the local sporting festivals and runs some events here on the school site for other local schools. These include a Fun Cross-Country run, and Local Area Primary school's competition. We are fortunate to have a well equipped and large sports hall that provides an excellent platform for the teaching of PE. Staff at Warbstow are skilled and enthusiastic educators. They have played competitively in sports themselves and taken opportunities in the past to become specialist teachers. (These include; Gymnastics, Hockey, Swimming, Badminton, Cycling, Football, netball, Keep fit, Horse Riding).

Each year all our children from Year 1 upwards enjoy taking part in a residential trip. This is a very valuable part of the children's learning. We take care to explore our locality and explore its rich history. The younger children take part in a variety of activities and sleep in the Community Hall; the KS2 children are offered the opportunity to go further afield to places such as Dartmoor and Bristol. Again, a focus on exploring our locality and linking this to the wider national areas are explored. Geography and History linked to where you live will have a far greater meaning to children's understanding of the world we inhabit.

On a global level, we have good links with our friends from Father Omeding School in Uganda. Opportunities to share messages via email and letters that explore life here and there, help to shine a light on the positive challenges that children face at schools all over the world.

ICT and Computing is a rapidly developing area and we are committed to keeping up with the times.
