BATH CITY FARM TRIP

As a part of our science work next term, we have organised a trip for years 3 and 4 to visit Bath City Farm. The children will find out about where our food comes from, get to feed the animals and learn some key facts. In addition, we will be going on a nature walk. As this is a rural setting and the children will be touching the animals, please let us know if your child has any allergies or fears.

We will leave school at 9am and return before the end of the school day. Therefore, children will need a packed lunch, a snack and plenty to drink.

The children will need to wear their blue Avenue sweatshirts or cardigans. However, tracksuit bottoms will need to be worn instead of school skirts or trousers as there are quite a lot of nettles. Please check the weather forecast. If the weather is wet, waterproof jackets will be required. If it is hot, sun cream and sun hats will be needed. All children will need to wear sturdy footwear or wellington boots.

We are splitting the department into 2 groups, visiting on either Friday 21st September or Friday 28th September.

Friday 21st September: Spain class and half of Italy class.

Friday 28th September: UK class and the other Italy class.

(Italy class, please note the date your child is visiting is highlighted on this letter).

The cost of the trip is **£7** which includes transport and workshops led by the Bath City Farm staff. The children **will not** require any further money to spend on the day.

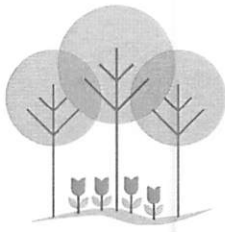
