Club Selection

We have been delighted by the interest shown in our new club programme. Where possible, we have tried to ensure that your child has been given at least one of their club preferences. For those where this was not possible we will contact you to organise alternatives. We appreciate that some children may be disappointed that they didn't get their first choice, however there will be the opportunity to select clubs again for term 3 and 4. Children who have been previously selected in oversubscribed clubs will not be given this preference again.

For your child's club selection please see the attached sheet. Your child has a place on the highlighted clubs only.

- If there is a charge for your child's club, please log on to Wise Pay to make the correct payment before your child starts their club.
- Children will not be allowed to start their club until the payment has been made.
- If your child is in receipt of free school meals, no payment is needed.
- Please can we remind you of the importance of your child attending clubs every week. We keep a register to monitor attendance. If your child frequently misses clubs, their place will be offered to another child on the waiting list.
- At the end of your child's club session, please ensure you collect them promptly from main reception. The club leader will bring them to you.

In addition to all of the 'sign up' clubs, don't forget we have many 'drop in' clubs too, which you can encourage your child to attend at lunchtime. These include: board games club, colouring room, aerobic/dance, team games, drawing, football, dance moves with dance start Jonny. We will be reminding children about these activities in school. For Key Stage 2 children, who have homework to complete, we have an after school 'drop in' session on Monday and a lunchtime session on Tuesday.

We look forward to seeing the children at their clubs from next week (WC Monday 1st October) when all clubs begin.
