### Standards at the end of Year 4 2019

We would expect that the vast majority of children in the last year at Southridge would be meeting year group related expectations (Year 4) in order that they are on track to achieve the expected standard at the end of Year 6 at Middle School.

There is no comparative data to measure our children's performance against schools nationally, however as you can see our children achieve extremely high standards.
