In Reception this half term we are learning about 'Finding out about my food' so have linked some exciting home learning for your child/ren to do by 29<sup>th</sup> March. We ask that adults at home try to do some/all of the activities with the children and question their choices to provoke enjoyment and curiosity with learning – this really can make a difference.

### Activity 1

#### English:

Draw and label some farm animals

#### Extra challenge

Write some facts about the animals

AND

Explore your kitchen cupboards together and talk about where different foods come from?

### Activity 2

#### Maths:

Visit a shop and use coins to buy low cost food items.

Discuss the value of the coins

Order real coins by value

#### Extra challenge

Make price labels and look at different ways to make the amounts e.g. 6p could be 5p+1p or 2p+2p+2p etc.

### Activity 3

#### Theme

Make a farmyard from junk modelling/Lego etc

and/or

Read stories about farm animals and discuss the animals

and/or

Match mother and baby animals, naming each one

and/or

Visit Hardy's Animal Farm or another animal farm

### General home learning

Read books every night for 20 minutes – your school book and exploring wonderful stories.

Discuss stories together – Who are the main characters? What are they like? What is the setting of the story? What might happen next?

Practice counting objects (up to 20) and matching the group to the numeral. Try including some 1 more/less questions.
