We ask that adults at home try and do some of the activities with the children and question their choices to provoke enjoyment and curiosity with learning – this really can make a difference.

Activity 1

English:

Write a report about the life of a famous explorer. It could be one that we have looked at in class or one that you are interested in...think space explorers or modern day explorers.

Fill your report with interesting facts and pictures about your chosen explorer.

Activity 2

Maths:

Be the teacher at home! We have been learning how to add and subtract in class. Create a poster that teaches someone how to complete these calculations...

$$45 + 32 = \qquad 66 + 29 =$$

$$78 - 36 = \qquad 62 - 37 =$$

Make your posters very clear!

Activity 3

Theme:

Think about an amazing place where an explorer might visit. Can you create a model of that place using a shoe box or something similar?

Create the different things you might find in that place – is it the jungle, or underwater, or even space?!
