Computing

Computing this term will be continuing in our pirate theme. We will program Bee-Bots and learn about Powerpoint.

English

We will continue to be working hard on our Read Write Inc Phonics during the Autumn Term helping us to become more fluent in our reading. We will also start to apply our learning across the curriculum. We will write letters and diaries in role as pirates as well as writing a story based on one of our pirate books—Pirates Next Door. As well as all this we will be using rhyme and pattern to help us to write beautiful poetry!

Maths

Our maths work this term will all be about being more confident with our knowledge of 2 digit numbers. We will use different concrete equipment and pictures to help us explore numbers under 100. We will then move on to developing our addition, subtraction and multiplication skills; becoming quicker at recalling number facts and learning new methods of calculating.

Science

Our Science learning this term is investigating different everyday materials and their uses. We will also spend time looking at animals too!

Geography

We will be practising our best pirate skills in Geography where we will be looking at maps and drawing our own.

Physical Education

In our indoor lessons, we will be exploring dance and gymnastics over the 2 half terms. During our games lessons (outside PE) we will build our skills in team games such as netball. Don't forget no ear-rings can be worn or covered for P.E. Please ensure your child has a kit in all week.

History

In History we will be learning all about life as a pirate; how pirates lived, what they wore and who was the most famous pirate.
