Ear rings

Please remember it is our school policy that children should only wear studs in their ears. These will need to be removed prior to the child being allowed to take part in PE. Teachers are not allowed to help children remove or insert earrings, nor are they allowed to allow children to participate in PE with tape over their earrings.
