**Computing**

In computing this term we will be using different softwares to change images. We will also be learning how to use the internet safely.

**English**

In our English work this term we will be writing our own information texts about bears and writing stories based in familiar settings. We will be reading all about the adventures of Paddington and building up our reading comprehension through guided reading. We will learn how to spot the past and present tense. We will move onto writing explanations and writing fantasy stories too.

**Maths**

Our maths work this term will focus around multiplication and division as well as continuing to practise our addition and subtraction skills across a range of situations. We will develop our measuring skills and look at how to handle data and statistics by reading and drawing different graphs before we move onto shape work and fractions after half term.

**Science**

Science this term is all about how we can work scientifically; making observations and predictions and then testing out our ideas to see if we are correct or not. We will continue to work with materials and how they are suitable.

**Geography**

In Geography we will be looking at the four countries of the UK as well as using directions and map symbols.

**Physical Education**

In PE Mr Borrell will be developing our gymnastics skills and we will be honing our ball skills as well as our throwing and catching too. PE sessions will be on a Monday and Thursday but we may need to go outside so make sure you have warm PE kit in school!

**History**

In History we are going to learn about the Royal family and then learn about the Great Fire of London. We will learn about how the fire started and what made it spread so much.

**DT**

Our DT work will include a spot of baking and cooking - get your taste buds ready for some school-cooked treats being brought home and we will also construct buildings and moving models.

**Music**

We will be learning how to sing rounds in music and learn some traditional songs, such as London's Burning and Oranges and Lemons.
