

## Year 2

### Activity 1

#### English:

Remember to use capital letters and full stops and choose exciting words!

### Activity 2

#### Maths:

Practise your number bonds as much as you can. Play the game I have sent home to help you know the pairs of numbers that make 10 and 20.

#### Theme:

Get modelling! Use materials from home to help you create a pirate-y model.
