### Activity 1

#### English:

Draw and label some minibeasts

#### Extra challenge

Write some facts about the insects

### Activity 2

#### Maths:

Use toys to add, subtract, double and halve numbers.

#### Extra challenge

Can you write related calculations?

### Activity 3

#### Theme

Grow a plant at home from a seed

and/or

Plant a pre-grown plant and take care of it. Discuss what it needs to grow

and/or

Go on a bug hunt

and/or

Draw a picture of some flowers Can you label the parts – stem, leaves, petals and roots.

### General home learning

Read books every night for 20 minutes – your school book and exploring wonderful stories.

Discuss stories together – Who are the main characters? What are they like? What is the setting of the story? What might happen next?

Practice counting objects (up to 20) and matching the group to the numeral. Try including some 1 more/less questions.
