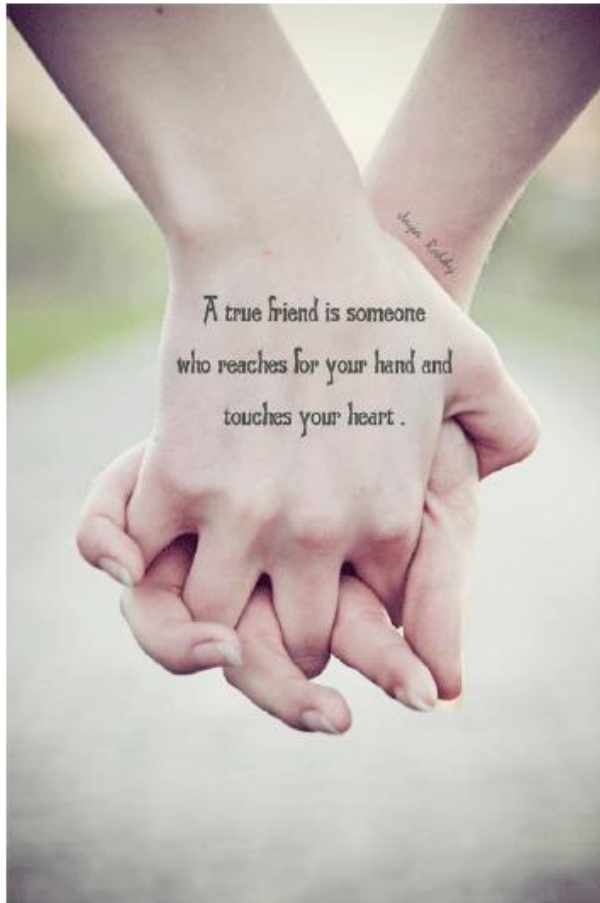


Newsletter Term 5: May 2020

I am also an avid reader. Prepare for lots of recommendations and encouragement to support those bookworms!

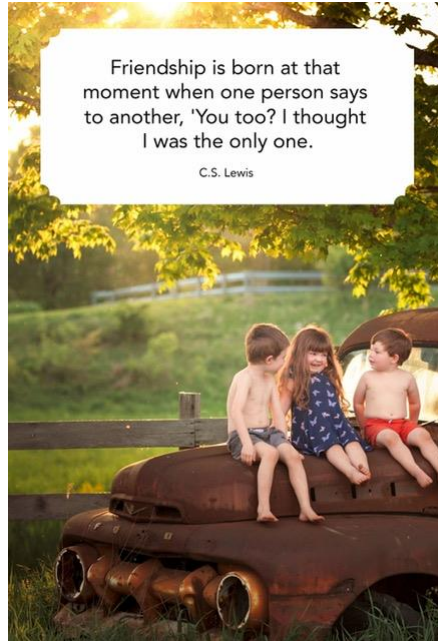

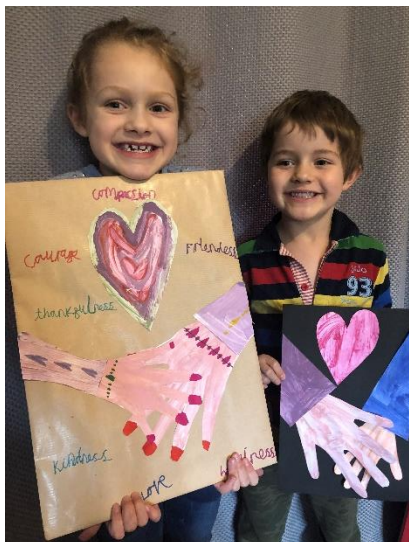
Our Christian value this term is friendship. What does friendship mean to you?

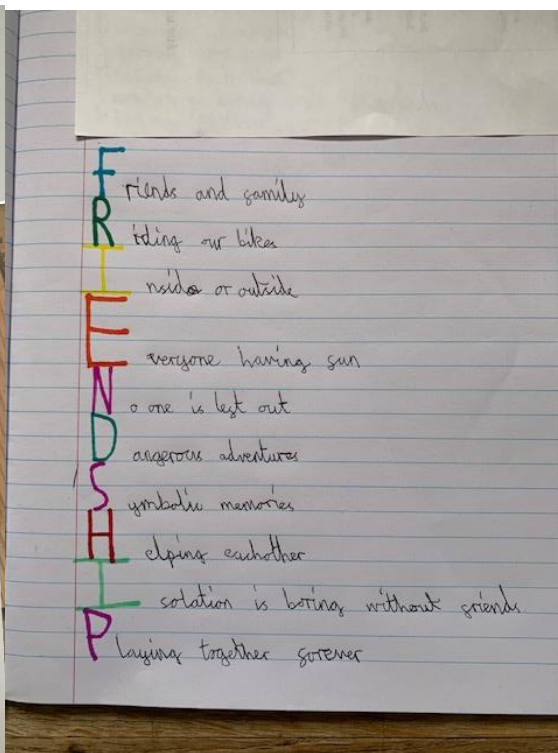
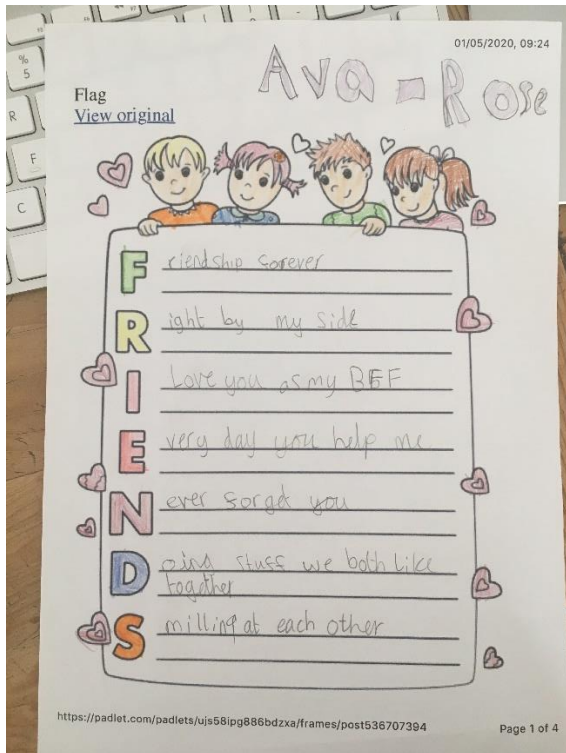
