<b>Mrs Arnold</b>	<b>Whole School Attendance w/c 11<sup>th</sup> October 2021 =97.7%</b>
<b>Whole School Reminders</b>	Reminders: <b><u>Parent Consultations</u></b> As you will be aware, next Thursday (21st October) will be our parent consultations. <b>F2</b>	Weekly Attendance w/c 11.10.21 <b>F2AJD = 98.02% F2AMC =98%</b> Over the past few weeks, the children have been thinking about how they have changed since they were a baby. This week we have looked at photographs to see how school and toys have changed over time too. Over the weekend, we would like the children to talk to parents or grandparents about what their school life and/or toys were like to find out what was similar and what was different. After the half term, we will begin to set homework tasks. Next week we will send home a reading log, which will contain more information about F2 homework, and any login details you need to access online platforms. Today, you will receive information from the PTA on how to create your own Christmas card and have it printed to be able to send out to friends and family. This is to be completed at home (if you wish to take part) and only to be returned to school for the PTA to send off when completed. Please ensure that phonics flashcards are returned to school each day.
<b>Y1</b>	Weekly Attendance w/c 11.10.21 <b>1SH =98.52% 1KE =96.3%</b> Reminder that phonics books should be read every evening and brought to school every day.
<b>Y2</b>	Weekly Attendance w/c 11.10.21 <b>2LR/JL=99.63% 2LH=96.28%</b> Can we remind you to please sign the children's yellow reading records each week to show that they have read their phonics books at home. PE will be on Monday only next week
<b>Y3</b>	Weekly Attendance w/c 11.10.21 <b>3ZM=98.52 % 3HC=100%</b> Please ensure an adult signs all Reading Records at least twice weekly. It is vital that our children are reading aloud daily to an adult, encompassing questioning and predicting. These records enable us to keep track of home reading and vocabulary understanding. <b>Y4</b>	<p>Weekly Attendance w/c 11.10.21  <b>4THC= 98.57% 4LS=96.18%</b></p> <p><b>No updates this week.</b></p>
<b>Y5</b>	<p>Weekly Attendance w/c 11.10.21  <b>5BG/AM=98.05 % 5JC= 98.85%</b></p> <p>This week, we will be having PE on Monday and Thursday. Please ensure school tracksuits are worn or PE kits are brought into school on these days.</p>
<b>Y6</b>	<p>Weekly Attendance w/c 11.10.21  <b>6FF=96.18 % 6PS= 94.79%</b></p> <p>Due to parents' consultations, there will be changes to staffing in Y6 on Thursday. Pupils will not be having PE on Thursday and therefore do not need their PE kits or school tracksuits in school.
