English grammar, punctuation and spelling test Paper 1: short answer questions (45 minutes) Break Paper 2: spelling (15 minutes)	Monday 14th May
English reading test Paper 1: Reading comprehension (60 minutes)	Tuesday 15th May
Mathematics Paper 1: arithmetic (30 minutes) Break Paper 2: reasoning (40 minutes)	Wednesday 16th May
Mathematics Paper 3: reasoning (40 minutes)	Thursday 17th May

SATs week tips:

1. We recommend that your child has an early night prior to each test day.
2. Morning break will be later during SATs week so it is vital that the children have a good breakfast to start the day. We are inviting all the children to an extra bite to eat in our free pre-SATs breakfast. A variety of cereals will be available in the KS2 hall from 8:30 and a bacon bap from 8:45am.
