Plants

- Identify and describe functions of different parts of flowering plants
- Explore the requirements of plants for life and growth
- Investigate how water is transported within plants

The Environment

- Recognise that living things can be grouped in a variety of ways
- Recognise that environments can change and this can sometimes pose dangers to living things

Other curriculum areas (ART/DT/RE/ and PE)

- ART/ DT: design a t-shirt with an ethical message
- Computing - design and write programmes designed for a specific purpose. Explore Bill Gates' impact on the world of technology
- History: The Battle of Britain. Historic racism in America and impact of Martin Luther King and Rosa Parks
- Geography - topographical features of South America including the Amazon Rainforest
- RE: Religious signs and symbols. What do we know about Jesus?
- PE: invasion games: hockey and football
