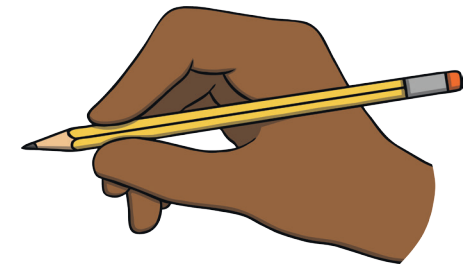

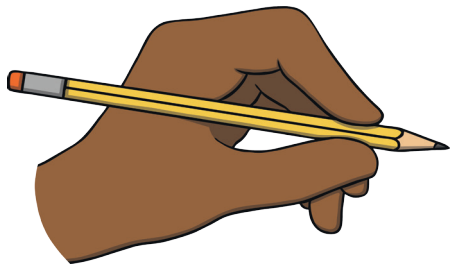

-ness	happiness
-ful	playful
-less	hopeless
-ly	angrily

Sometimes suffixes change the end of the root word.
