Use of social media

It has come to our attention that children are signing up to 'WhatsApp' and other social media. Crisp packet recycling scheme

School Uniform

A reminder that school uniform consists of: grey/black trousers or skirts, royal blue pullover or cardigan, white shirts/polo shirts. Blue/white checked dresses (summer term). **All** footwear should be black in colour and well fitting (shoes not trainers). Heavy boots, high heels, flimsy sandals etc., are not allowed.

PE: Children need a pair of black shorts, a plain white T shirt and black plimsolls/trainers. Track suit bottoms are permitted during the winter months only (but in addition to not instead of shorts).

Jewellery: The only items of jewellery permitted are two gold or silver ear studs (plain and small). No face jewellery is permitted. An inexpensive watch may also be worn as long as the wearer can tell the time.
