Religious Education

We will be learning about Christianity and Judaism and exploring the question 'How should we care for the world and for others, and why does it matter?'

PE

We will be developing our striking and fielding skills ready for sports day.

Science

We will be observing and describing changes in weather, the seasons and how day length varies.

Working scientifically to make tables and charts to record our findings. We will create a display showing what happens in the world around us.

Music

Our unit this term is called 'Reflect, Rewind and Replay', where we will revisit and perform some of our favourite songs.

We will also be exploring 'Samba' and 'Carnival' music and creating our own instruments.

Computing

Our unit this term is called 'Digital Literacy'.

We will be learning how to use technology safely as well as keeping ourselves safe online.

Art and Design Technology

We will be exploring patterns in carnival costumes and learning to sew a simple pattern of our own.

We will be using clay to sculpt Amazonian animals.

History and Geography

We will be using world maps, atlases, and globes to locate Brazil.

By using simple fieldwork and observational skills, we will draw a simple map of the school.

We will be looking at historical places in our own locality (Indian Queens Pit).

PHSE

Our SCARF unit this term is called 'Growing and Changing'.

We will be learning about our bodies and how they change as well as keeping ourselves and our bodies safe.

Mathematics

We will be revisiting addition and subtraction.

As well as learning the following:-

Names and properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

Simple fractions ($1/2$ and $1/4$).

Reading time to the hour and half past.

Ordering days of the week and months of the year.

Position and direction – looking at clockwise and anti-clockwise as well as full turn, half and quarter turns.

English

We will be reading the Amazonian traditional tale 'Jabuti the Tortoise' and creating an information leaflet about Brazil.
